





## ADMISSION PROCESS 2019-2020

In order to apply for enrollment at the Fort Worth Academy of Fine Arts (FWAFA), students must submit an application AND successfully complete the audition process. Students whose parent/guardian currently resides in any of the following TEA-approved ISDs are eligible to apply:

The entire process for application includes the following steps:

1. Applications must be received by Monday, February 11, 2019.
2. You are assigned an audition date and time upon submission of the application. Due to the large volume of applicants, we are unable to honor special requests for audition times which are assigned on a first come, first serve basis.
3. Arrive to your audition 15 minutes early.
4. You will receive notification by mail. Letters are mailed the third week in March regarding the status of applicant's acceptance. When there are more eligible applicants than available openings, applicants are placed on a waitlist. Applicants are offered enrollment based on their ranking and FWAFA's availability in the appropriate grade level.

Applicants will receive one of the following:

- Acceptance Letter: Scores were acceptable for admission and an opening is available
- Waitlist Letter: Scores were acceptable for admission but there are no openings
- Non-Acceptance Letter: Scores did not meet the minimum standards for admission

Applicants must be prepared to audition as early as January 10, 2019.

Auditions continue through the week of March 4, 2019 by appointment only.

In the case of illness, an audition may be rescheduled by contacting [admission@fwafa.org](mailto:admission@fwafa.org) prior to the original appointment. The school will assign a new audition date and time, which shall be within 10 days of the originally scheduled audition. A doctor's note must be submitted at the time of the new appointment.

Auditions are held on the FWafa campus. Parents/Guardians may bring their auditioning child on the scheduled date; however, parents may not accompany the child into the audition room.

Auditions are scored using the related rubric found on the Admission tab of our website. An incomplete audition presentation will result in a loss of points.

Scores are calculated and ranked within each grade level regardless of audition area.

The audition rubric will be used to rank each child with minimum score requirements within his/her grade level. Ranking determines each child's position on the acceptance and waitlists.

Resumes, academic standings, and letters of recommendation are not considered for admission; only audition scores are considered for admission.

Acceptance for admission is contingent upon successful completion of the student's current grade level.

Students will not receive a copy of the completed rubric or score.
